

**Sandy Dennis  
1937-1992**

Sandy Dennis was a brilliant actress whose work spanned three decades. She appeared in 26 movies, 12 Broadway shows, and countless regional productions. Born in Hastings, she lived in Kenesaw for a year or two, and graduated high school and attended two semesters of college in Lincoln. A starring role in a community theatre production marked the start of her career. In addition to her work as an actress and her Nebraska heritage, she was well-known for her love of animals. Dennis died from ovarian cancer at her home in Westport, Connecticut, at age 54.

*Come Back to the Five and Dime Jimmy Dean, Jimmy Dean* is a 1982 comedy-drama film and an adaptation of Ed Graczyk's 1976 play. The Broadway and screen versions both starred Sandy Dennis, Cher, Mark Patton, Karen Black, Sudie Bond and Kathy Bates. As with the original play, the film takes place inside a small Woolworth's five-and-dime store in a small Texas town, where an all-female fan club for actor James Dean reunites in 1975. Through a series of flashbacks, the six members also reveal secrets dating back to 1955. Both the play and film were directed by Robert Altman.
